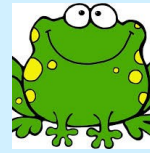

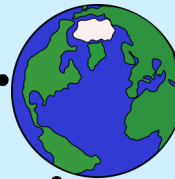

ART

We will be focusing on Narrative Paintings (Paintings that tell a story).

Drawing from different building designs and studying the features of different buildings.



ENGLISH

In English this term we will be looking at the book *Oliver's Vegetables*. This book is about a boy who visits his Grandpa and tries a range of Vegetables all throughout the week. The children will focus on using adjectives to describe, begin to punctuate sentences using an exclamation mark and use the 'est' ending.

HISTORY AND GEOGRAPHY

In History we will be learning about the great fire of London and are lucky enough to be taking part in an exciting workshop for this in the first week back!

In Geography we will be looking at life in Kenya and comparing it to our lives.

MATHS

In Maths this term we will be learning multiplication and division and place value!



We will be looking at counting in 2's, 5's and 10's, making equal groups, adding by repeated addition, learning about the time, and money. It will be a busy, mathematical Summer

RSHE

This half term we will be learning about 'Relationships, how to make friends and how to solve friendship problems. We will also look at what makes a good friendship and learn how to treat people with respect.

Next half term we will be looking at 'changing me' which focusses on understanding that everyone is unique and special and how to respect the changes that they see in others.

Children will be learning how to identify the parts of the body that makes boys different to girls and they will be using the correct vocabulary for this (penis, testicles, vagina, vulva and anus).

SCIENCE

We will be learning all about different types of weather and how weather changes from season to season. In summer 2 we will be learning about Taking Care of the Earth by saving energy and recycling different materials.
