If you require an appointment at any time to discuss anything, please contact the school office who will be happy to arrange a mutually agreeable time.

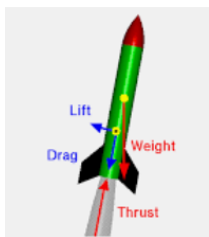

History and Science

Our History this term is 'Ancient Greeks'.



Through the research of artefacts, the children will discuss life and pastimes of the Ancient Greek period. We will study Ancient Greek achievements and how they have influenced the Western world. In Art the children will study the history of Greek pottery and create their own plus other exciting art and design technology linked to this.



In science we will be looking at the force of gravity and have some fantastic experiments planned !!! The children will learn how to use language to describe air resistance. We will discuss how air resistance and gravity interact.



PE

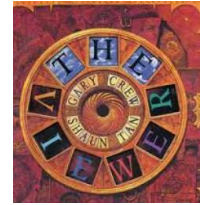
In PE the children will be taught ball skills, team work and fitness through basketball and netball.

This term the children will discuss how to stay positive and motivated when doing something challenging. They will learn how to work hard to achieve their own dreams and goals.

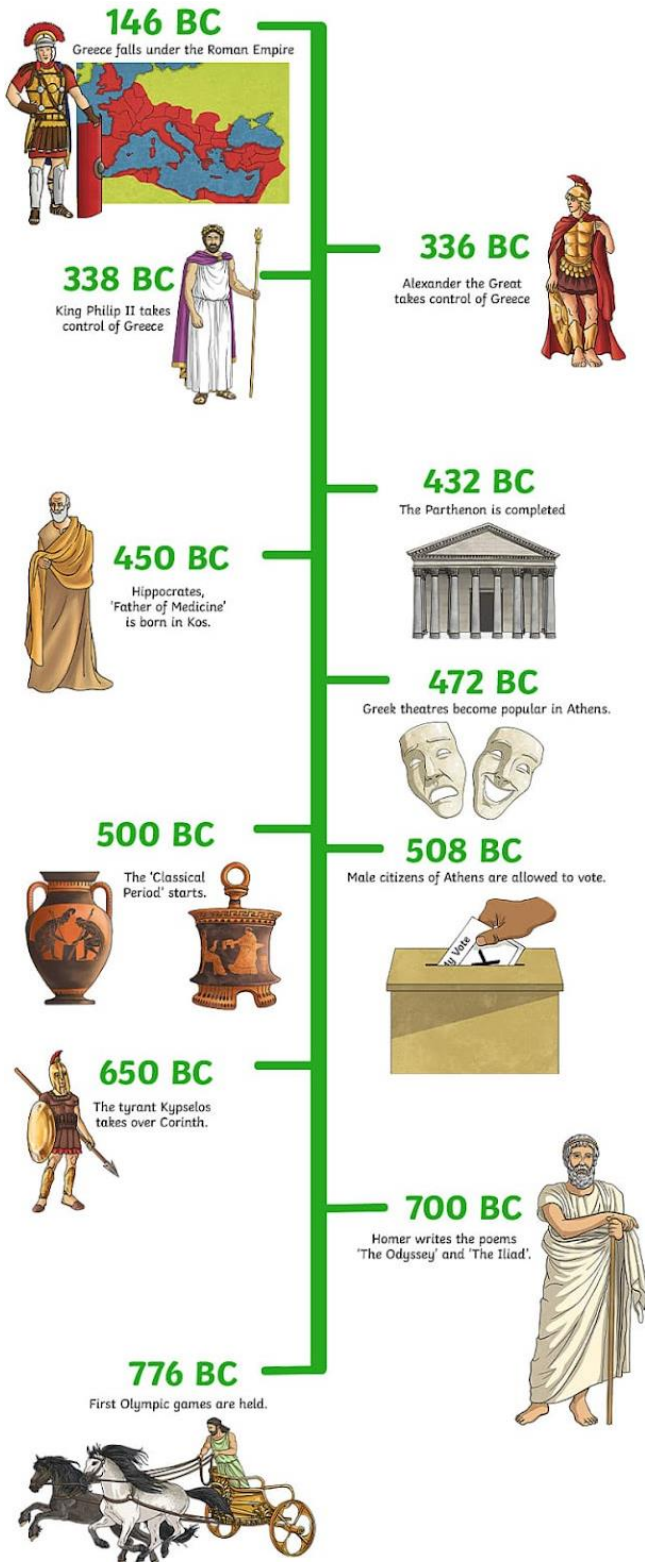

Key Facts

We know about Ancient Greece from a range of different sources – pottery, art work, tablet writing.

Ancient Greece spanned hundreds of years from 700BCE to 146BCE.

Ancient Greeks were at the same time as the end of Ancient Egyptian era and at the same times as the Bronze Age in Britain!

Impact on us

- Created the first modern alphabet
- Advances in science and medicine that still help us today
- Created democracy and used this in Greek cities
- Created the first Olympics. These were different then than they are today
- Theatre – Greek plays are still performed.

Several myths and legends have survived from Ancient Greek times including Pandora's Box, Theseus and the Minotaur, Hercules, The Adventures of Odysseus and The Trojan War.
