




Spring 1 in Year 1



ENGLISH

We will begin the half term with our poetry week. We will be looking at the poem 'If I had a Beak' by the Literacy Company. Children will finish this by adding their own lines to the poem.

After this our unit for the rest of the half term will be based around the book 'The Lion Inside'. We will finish by writing our own fiction, journey stories in which the children will write a story about a small animal (mouse) who befriends a large animal in the African Savannah.

This half term we will continue learning about 'being me in my world'. This will include discussions about:

Music


