It was great. It wasn't just the choir performing. It was nice to have a rest in between and watching other children perform - Niall

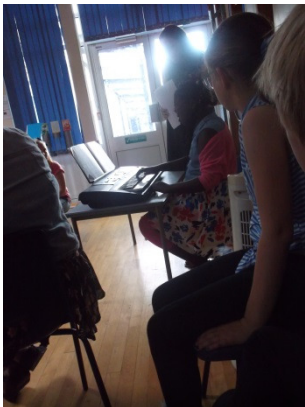
I love playing my recorder and singing in the choir. It is amazing. Katie
