



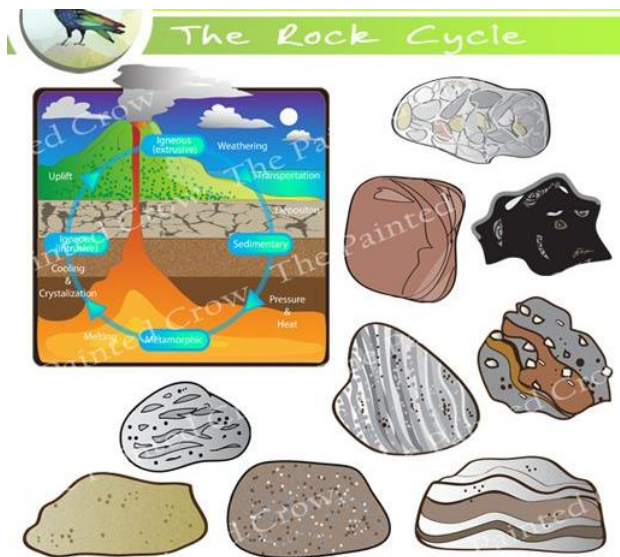
Science at Moorlands
