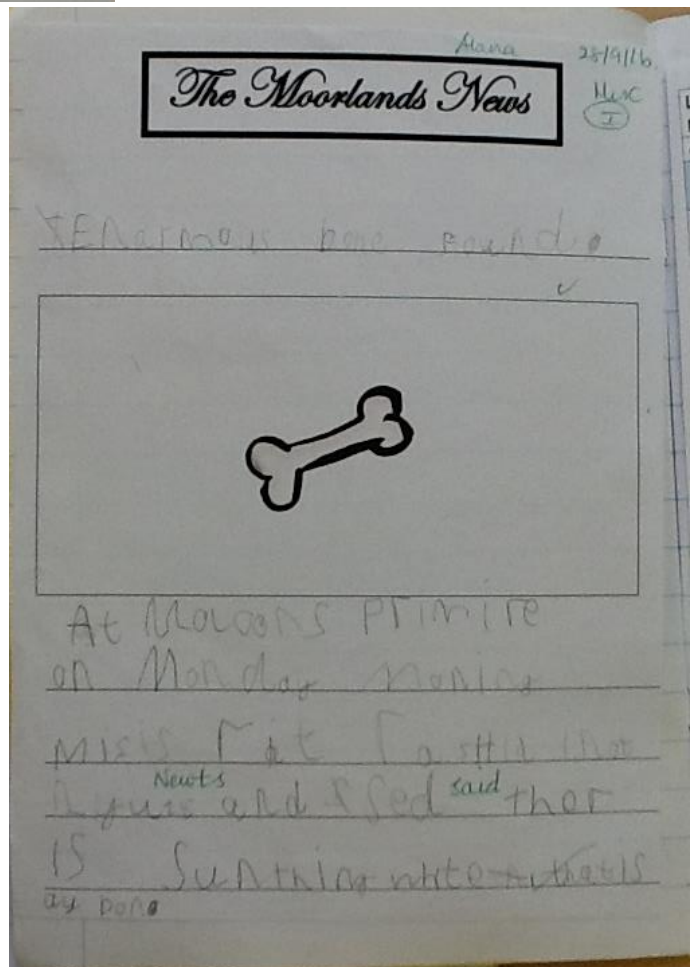
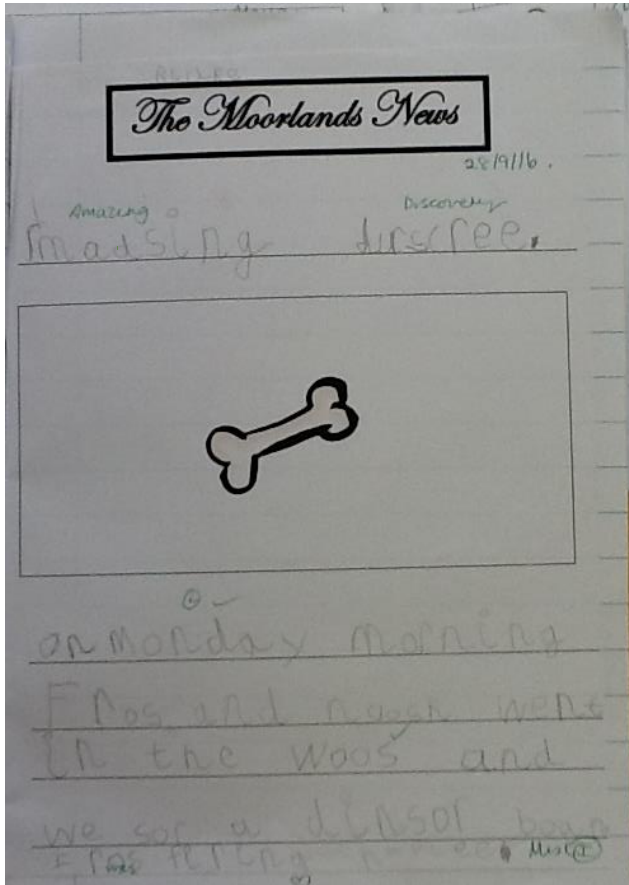

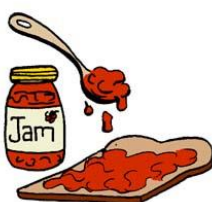


Jam Sandwiches

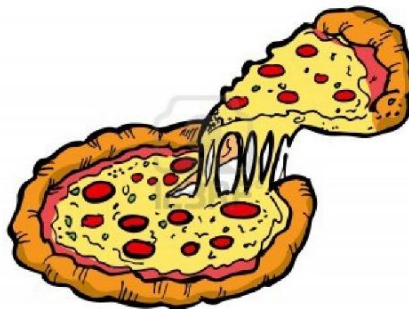

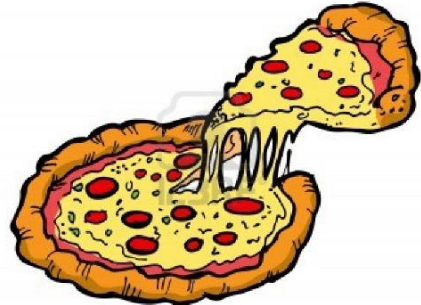
