



Autumn 2 in Year 1



ENGLISH

In English this term we will be reading *The Three Little Pigs*. Children will learn about capital letters and finger spaces. They will also recount the story, sequence the story and create a story map.



Maths



In Maths this term, we will be learning all about the composition of numbers through concrete resources, part-whole models and missing number problems.

The children will also extend their understanding of **subtraction**.

Science

In science, this term year 1 will be learning about animals. We will discuss different features of animals, e.g. fur, claws, diet, size. We will also learn about animal habitats and their locations around the globe.



History

This half term, yr1 will be studying **significant British explorers**. These include Captain Cook, Ernest Shackleton and Francis Drake. We will discuss their achievements, their discoveries and the effects they had



on British history.

Geography

In Geography, we will learn about island formation with a focus on the Galapagos Islands. The Galapagos Islands are located near Ecuador and are a hotspot for wildlife.



PSHE



This half term we will continue learning about 'being me in my world'. This will include discussions about:

- ☺ helping others to feel welcome
- ☺ making our school community a better place
- ☺ everyone's right to learn
- ☺ caring about the feelings of others
- ☺ working well with others
- ☺ following our learning charter

RE

This half term, the children are learning about the symbol of light.



Art

We will be studying **sculpture**.

This means 3D art made by moulding clay, carving wood and stone, creating installations and many other techniques.



Music

In music, we will be using our voices to create different sounds or blend with the group. They focus on hearing and performing simple intervals with our voices, using Kodaly songs. This builds on the songs learnt in reception. Listen to the songs and check that you understand how to perform all the activities before teaching the unit.

Computing

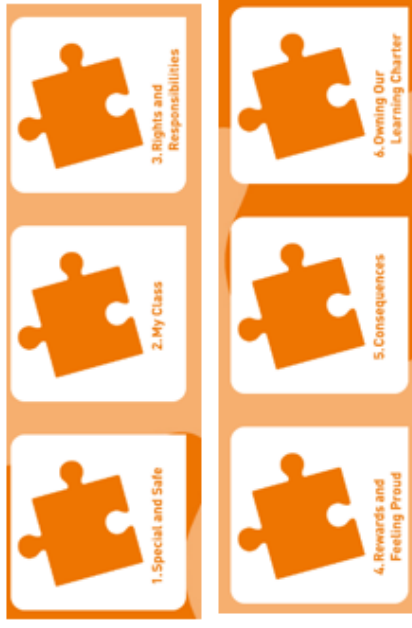
In this unit, we will learn how to use an online drawing platform to create digital artwork using different tools and techniques.
