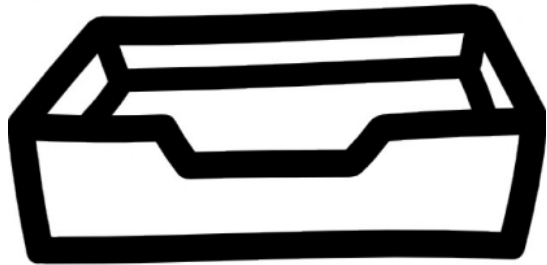
Please ensure that your child has a **named**, water bottle in school everyday. The school bottles (or just the lids) can be bought at the school office
