



Year 1 Stir Fry

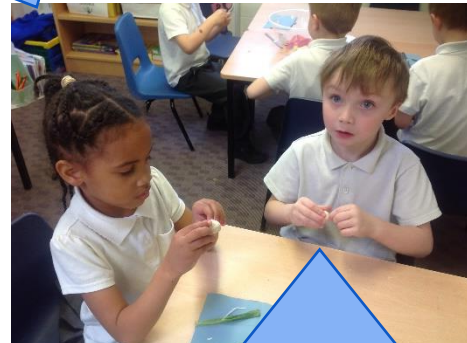
