

### ENGLISH

In English this term we will be working on our speaking and listening skills. We will be reading lots of amazing books and using them to help with our writing.



We will continue to work towards our reading and writing targets. We will also work on editing and improving our work.

### MATHS

In Maths this term we will be consolidating our addition and subtraction skills. We will be applying our number bonds within 10, 20 and 100 to help us



calculate quickly. We will also revisit multiplication and division. We will also learn about measurement, including capacity.

### GEOGRAPHY

## Water Bottles




