English

In English this half term, we are going to be using the text *The True Story of the 3 Little Pigs* to write a newspaper report about the events of the story according to the wolf.



Maths

In Maths this half term, we will be continuing our unit on measures, first of all finishing our unit on volume and capacity, then a unit on money and then learning about time.

Science

In Science this half term, we will be learning about light. This will include how light travels and about reflectors as well as how we can see light.



Guided Reading

In Guided Reading this half term, we are using the text *The Owl Who Was Afraid of the Dark* to consolidate our fluency and comprehension skills.

History

This half term in History, we are learning about Anglo Saxons, we will find out about why they came to Britain, about their homes, warriors and what happened while they were here.



Geography

This half term, we are learning about Western Europe. We will be finding out about the characteristics of some of the countries in western Europe and compare to the UK.



Computing

We are learning about computer science in our computing unit this half term and will use the website *Blockly Games* to support the children's coding skills.

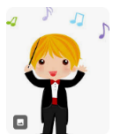


RE

Art

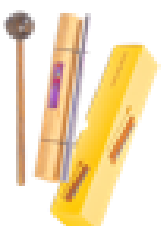
This half term, the children will be learning how to draw architecture. We will use familiar landmarks and consider the different elevations as well as viewpoints.

OfE Statutory Relationships & Health Education Guidance:

OfE Statutory Relationships and Health Education Guidance: Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) is a statutory requirement for all secondary schools. It is designed to help young people understand their own and others' feelings about puberty and the changing adolescent body, particularly from age 9 through to age 11, including physical and emotional changes (OfE) about mental wellbeing (including the link between the menstrual cycle and mental health).

OfE (2021) states there is a normal range of emotions (e.g., happiness, sadness, anger, fear, surprise, embarrassment) and scales of emotions that all humans experience in relation to different experiences and situations (e.g., how to recognise and talk about their emotions, including using a varied vocabulary of words to use when talking about their own and others' feelings (OfE) key facts about puberty and the changing adolescent body, particularly from age 9 through to age 11, including physical and emotional changes (OfE) about mental wellbeing (including the link between the menstrual cycle and mental health).
