# Librarians (Max of 8 places)



- Keeping the reading area(s) tidy at all times throughout the week
- Making sure that books are in the correct positions ready to be used (like a book shop)
- Supporting the library staff with any jobs at lunchtime and running the library book swap club when things get back to normal
- Helping the younger children scan books in and out during lunchtime in our “Library swap club”
- Helping the younger children to select age appropriate books
- Setting up book displays and a library environment for the whole school



# Reading club leader



- Reading club will be at lunchtimes for the younger children to come and hear a story being read to them in the reading area
- Supporting the reading area outside and keeping this tidy and organised throughout the week (breaks and lunches)
- This will be a role that will suit avid readers who feel comfortable reading aloud to others and love reading themselves
- This role will also suit someone who enjoys spending time with younger children



# Technology leaders (Max of 3 people)



- Checking laptops are plugged in and charged in the oak building
- Checking the IPADS are away and charged for the whole school to use
- Supporting teachers in assemblies with the ICT equipment – including the use of music – when these are up and running.
- Cleaning the technology to support teachers
- Are you excellent with a laptop? Can you lead a lunchtime laptop club teaching computing skills? We will consider adding this to the role for the right people....in the near future



# PA to Teachers/staff



- Being a personal assistant to Mr Turner, Mrs WB, staff and/or SLT at lunchtime to help with any jobs
- Jobs could include; cutting and laminating, tidying, shredding, sorting out stationary and deliveries, cleaning and setting up rooms for afternoon learning
- Be keen to help and supportive during lunch times
- Using a weekly rota to follow duties given



# Lunch time leaders



- Supporting Mrs Deadman-Rose with running lunch time games throughout the week (in the future)
- Being kind, supportive and friendly with the younger children
- Playing games with the younger children
- Helping to set up and tidy up after the club
- Using a rota throughout the week – showing organisational skills



# Guardian leaders



- Supporting Mrs Deadman-Rose and lunchtime supervisors with the year R, Year 1 and 2 children (KS1)
- You get to wear a GUARDIAN jacket!
- Being kind, supportive and friendly with the younger children
- Taking them to/from first aid/the toilets
- Playing games with the younger children
- Using a rota throughout the week – showing organisational skills





# Outdoor learning leaders



- Supporting Mrs W-B with keeping the outdoor learning grounds up together
- Being useful with tools outside showing responsibility
- Be a keen groundsman/woman who enjoys outside nature
- Be happy to give up lunchtimes/after school throughout the year
- Come up with new ideas for the school site – being creative!
- Litter picking/keeping the site tidy for visitors/staff/children etc



# Collective worship leader (Max of x4 places)



- Putting the benches out for year 6 when there is a whole school collective worship
- Putting out benches for celebration collective worship
- Counting the house points at lunch time (on a Thursday ready for Friday)
- Reading out attendance and house cup winners in Friday's assembly – this might include being stood at the front of the hall or virtually on camera
- You will be line managed by Miss Roughton



**\*NEW (ish) ROLE\***

**House captain**

**(Max of 8 people - x2 per house)**



- Being a lead captain of your house team for sport events (hopefully coming soon)
- Lifting the house point trophy in assemblies if your house wins
- Enjoy playing and taking part in a variety of sport events
- Plan sport house events for the whole school to take part in (this could be any sporting event!)
- Playing games with the younger children/being a positive influence



# Application



- Take an application home today and complete by Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> September handing in to your class teacher
- Complete the application for the leader role you would like to apply for – if you would like to apply for more than 1 role, please complete as many applications as needed
- Include as much information as possible as to why you would be the right person for the role – lots of roles have lots of applications so make sure you “sell yourself”
- We had lots of applications last year so make yours stand out to us
- Staff spend a lot of time considering the applications so don’t rush them, take your time and make sure you include as much detail as you can.
