

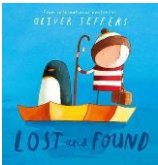


Autumn 1 in Year 1!



ENGLISH

In English this term we will be reading *Lost and Found*. The children will be working on this book over the half term – engaging in lots of writing tasks as well as speaking and listening lessons to help them to write their own story.



PSHE

This half term we will be learning about 'being me in my world' this will include discussions based around:

helping others to feel welcome, making our school community a better place, everyone right to learn, caring about others feelings, working well with others, following our learning charter

The vocabulary we will be covering is:

safe, special, calm, belonging, rights, responsibilities, learning charter, rewards, proud, consequences, upset, disappointed, illustration.

Maths



In Maths this term, we will be learning all about Place value within 10. The children will be grouping and sorting items based on different characteristics such as: colour, size and shape. We will also be looking at addition and subtraction of numbers within 10.

History

This half term, we are learning about the Ice Age. We will explore the different environments, different animals and how they survived in such harsh conditions.



RE

This half term, the children are learning about the concept of symbolism (bread).



Art

We will be learning about prehistoric art elements, line and colour. We will be looking at prehistoric art that was produced before the time of recorded history.



Science

In science, this term year 1 will be learning about plants and their growth. We will conduct an experiment to see which environment allows our plants to grow best.



Geography

In Geography, we are learning about gaining spatial sense through looking at maps and points of view. It helps us to understand how we relate to everything around us including things on planet Earth.

Music

In music, we will be using our voices to create different sounds or blend with the group. They focus on hearing and performing simple intervals with our voices, using Kodaly songs. This builds on the songs learnt in reception. Listen to the songs and check that you understand how to perform all the activities before teaching the unit.

Computing

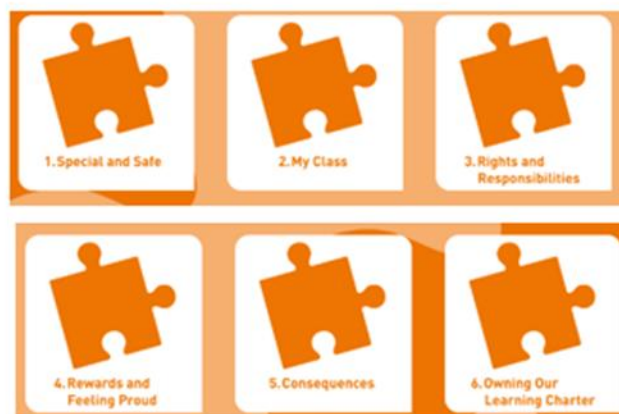
In this unit, we will learn how to use an online drawing platform to create digital artwork using different tools and techniques.
