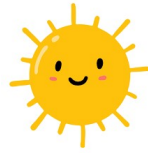


# Summer 2 in Year 1

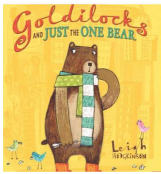


## English

Our English unit this half term will start with a poetry focus. We will be getting creative by writing a poem about fruit using senses vocabulary in a shape and join with others to make a 'fruit salad' poetry sequence.



In English this half term, we will be focusing on traditional fairy tales. Based around the book 'Goldilocks and just one bear'. The children will be able to write a new version of the story with a new character or new setting.



## PSHE



This half term in PSHE we will be looking into an important and reassuring topic: 'Changing Me.' Over the next few weeks, we will be exploring the life cycles of both animals and humans. The children are already beginning to understand that growing up brings many different changes—both on the outside and the inside. Most importantly, our focus is on building confidence and reassurance. We are learning that change is a completely natural part of life, and that it is absolutely OK! > Home Discussion Tip: Ask your child what changes they've noticed in themselves since they started this school year. It's a wonderful way to celebrate how much they are growing!

## Maths

This half term in maths we will be Learning about place value, money and time.



## Science

In science this half term, we will be learning about looking after our Earth. The children will explore how we can reduce waste, the importance of recycling, and the small everyday changes we can make to protect the environment and wildlife around us.



## History-

This half term, we will be diving into 19th-century Britain. They will be exploring what life was really like during the Victorian era, discovering everything from incredible inventions to the daily lives of children just like them.

## Geography

In our geography work this half term we will be learning all about London. Children will have an understanding of where they live an understanding that London is the capital city of England. They will have an understanding of how to use maps to describe locations



## RE

In our RE lessons we will be reflecting on special books and looking in more detail at the bible, the special book for Christians. We will read and discuss a number of different bible stories.



## Music

In our Music work this half term we will work through the various stages of writing a class song. Children will work collaboratively to write verses, a chorus and the accompaniment for their song.



## Art

This half term, in art will explore Architecture. We will be learning how buildings are planned, designed, and constructed. The unit focuses on examining different building designs and identifying the unique features that define various structures. We will build on our knowledge of 2D and 3D shapes to create art.



## Computing

This half term we will be looking at toys and beebots. In this unit, we will learn to code simple devices and online programs.
