



Summer 1 in Year 3!



English

In English this half term, we are going to be using the text *The True Story of the 3 Little Pigs* to write a newspaper report about the events of the story according to the wolf.



Maths

In Maths this half term, we will be finishing our unit on Fractions and then we will be looking at Mass and Capacity.



Science

In Science this half term, we are looking at Plants and how they grow. We are learning how water transports around the plant as well as experiments surrounding plant growth.



Guided Reading

We will be using the text *The Illustrated Atlas of Britain and Ireland* to practice the children's non-fiction reading skills. This will also link to our Geography work for this half term.



History

This half term in History, we are learning about The Roman Empire and the impact that has had on Britain today. We are also going to be learning about

Boudicca's rebellion.



Geography

This half term, we are going to learn all about our local area and how the land use has changed over time.



Computing

We are using the website code.org for our Computing unit this half term on Coding. The children will learn how to create loops and sequences for a game.



RE

This half term, the children are learning about Creation. They will be learning about various Creation stories for Christians.



Music

In Music this half term we will look at the work of the composer, Edvard Grieg, and in particular his famous piece, *Morning Mood*. This will lead to us studying time signatures, playing melodies on the glockenspiel and creating compositions to portray peaceful scenery.



PSHE

This half term's unit is Relationships. Please find attached the knowledge organiser and vocabulary list for this unit.



Art

This half term, the children will be learning how to draw portraits. We will also be using the artist Julian Opie as inspiration for our portraits.



DT

In DT, the children will be learning how to make a hollow structure. They will be designing, constructing and evaluating their structures.



PE

For indoor PE, we will be creating dance pieces inspired by the Olympics. For outdoor PE, we will be learning key Netball skills.



French

We will build on our knowledge of everyday language by learning the days of the week. We will also study the geography of France and any major cities, focussing on Paris and its famous landmarks.
